

Good afternoon:

Tomorrow, November 16th, we will resume face to face learning following our normal schedule. Thank you to students, families, and staff as we successfully practiced a remote learning day last Friday. The District will continue to reflect on our remote plan and implement improvements in the event it is ever necessary to implement in the uncertain future.

As we transition into the holiday season and push to the end of the first semester prior to winter break, we need your help to keep our school as healthy as possible and prevent any further closures. It is going to take the entire community, pulling together in the same direction, to ensure our students can continue in person learning.

As a part of school registration, a parent or guardian of each student signed off to certify the health of their student will be monitored each day prior to attending to school. It is extremely important parents and guardians remain diligent in daily monitoring. Since viruses spread person to person, please keep your child home if they are sick. Sick day guidelines are as follows:

- Temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- COVID-19 symptoms: Fever, cough, shortness of breath, muscle aches, sore throat, headache, congestion, loss of taste and smell, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.
- Medical evaluation and COVID-19 testing are necessary for all students and staff with COVID-like symptoms.

Any students presenting to school with the above symptoms will be isolated and parents will be called to pick up the child. Please be contemplating a family plan for if your child becomes sick at school and cannot attend.

Thank you for your cooperation. Your diligence in keeping our students healthy and safe play a significant role in ensuring student's continued participation in face to face learning. Please implement safe practices of mask wearing, hand washing, and social distancing into your daily home and weekend practices. I cannot reinforce enough the importance of 24/7 implementation of safety guidelines for our entire community. Diligence on your part will have a huge impact on our ability as a school community to keep students safe and in school. Please do you part.
