JOSTENS - The year has just begun ... but believe it or not ... we already need to plan for the end of the year. The Jostens company handles the items that are needed for graduation. In order to participate in the graduation ceremony, seniors must have a cap, gown, stole and tassel.

Our Jostens representative, Troy Hall, will be here on **Wednesday, September 26** from 11:00-11:30 to present information about ordering caps & gowns, invitations, jewelry and other senior apparel items. If a senior cannot be at that meeting, I will save a packet with all of the information. However, it is important that the senior (or parent) comes to get that packet as soon after the meeting as possible.

Troy will return to take orders on **Wednesday, October 3** from 11:00 - 11:30. On that day, he will need the order form and a **\$60 deposit** (cash, credit card info or check payable to Jostens). **If you cannot be here at that time, it is very important that you get your order and deposit to Mr. Zecher before the 3rd... be sure to include sizes for any clothing items ordered.** Jostens will bill you directly for any remaining balance. They also offer the option of spreading payments out over several months.

HOMECOMING WEEK will be October 1 - 6 with the Variety Show and Coronation on Thursday, October 4 game on Friday, October 5 and dance on Saturday, October 6.

SENIOR PORTRAITS - Each year, we take formal pictures of Seniors in graduation gown. These portraits will be taken **Thursday, November 15**... we're guessing **between 10am and 11am**. These photos are very important since they will be displayed in three ways... the yearbook, the special senior class sections of local newspapers, as well as the Class of 2019 photo collage that is displayed with all the other graduating classes in the school entrance. **This is the only time that portraits are taken, so please mark your calendar (especially if you are not normally in the high school building at that time).** You are able to order prints of the portrait ... order packets will be distributed later.
